Landscape on Saturday

The grounds of the gallery provide a beautiful landscape in the centre of the City, Modern two was originally built in 1833 as the Dean Orphan Hospital and converted into a gallery in 1999. As well as its historic setting, the garden provides spectacular views with many mature trees and an excellent opportunity to specialise in textures, colour, light and shade working outside. If the weather is inclement the high walls provide protection from wind and rain.

Basic materials are required: paper - A2 if possible, light weight board, pencils and any materials you wish to use, if using paint a palette and jar. I will bring along pastels to lend and demonstrate and I am happy to help out with any media.

We have permission to sketch inside if it totally pours down but I always expect sunshine or at least dry weather.
